



# 5) Unit Price in US\$ Only.




### 6) Label Printing

Choose USPS Global Parcel Express/Super Express, which will connect to USPS server to get tracking#.




# 7) Using Mail Plus/e-Pelican White/Yellow Label (4 x10)

Although below Print screen shows the label at the center, it will print labels as below (A).






Above (B) is NG and can not be used for the shipments.

# 8) Using Standard White Label (4 x 6)


Please check "Choose paper source by PDF page size".

# 9) Affixing Labels.

Four labels will be printed. We can provide the pouch. (ULINE# S-750)

GSS will print four labels for an international package:

- 1. The Mailing Label
- 2. The Customs Declaration
- 3. A second copy of the Customs Declaration
- 4. The Dispatch Note

### It is critical that these labels be placed properly on the package. The core requirements are:

- The Mailing Label must be affixed to the outside of the package and not in a plastic sleeve.
- The Customs Declaration must be completely and clearly visible on the package.

There are different shape-specific guidelines depending on whether the item being mailed is a Box (with six sides) or an Envelope or Pouch (with only two sides).

#### For Boxes:

- The Mailing Label and Customs Declaration should be affixed to the outside of a package, on the same side.
- The Dispatch Note and the second copy of the Customs Declaration should be placed in an attached plastic sleeve, with the backing still on both labels.

#### Exceptions for Boxes:

- a. If the package is not large enough to affix the Mailing Label, Customs Declaration, and plastic sleeve to its front, the plastic sleeve should be placed on another side of the package.
- b. If the package is not large enough for both the Mailing Label and Customs Declaration to be affixed to its front, then the Mailing Label should be affixed to the front and the Customs Declaration should be affixed to one side.







### For Envelopes or Pouches:

The Mailing Label should be affixed to one side of the package and the plastic sleeve should be placed on the other side with both Customs Declarations and the Dispatch Note in the sleeve. The Customs Declaration must be clearly visible through the plastic sleeve and not obscured in any way.

All packages in the SACKS may be shipped as Global Parcel Economy (First-Class Mail International).
